



Constitution of
The Saskatchewan Physical Education Association
Incorporated in 1980

Article I

Name

The name of the association shall be the Saskatchewan Physical Education Association Inc. (SPEA).

Article II

Affiliation

The council shall be affiliated with the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation as a Professional growth network.

Article III

Objectives

The objectives of the professional growth network shall be:

- a) To support and enhance the professional growth of members regarding promotion and support of quality physical education which will provide the foundation for active healthy lifestyles, wellness, recreation and sport at all levels of the education system.
- b) To offer advice and recommendations to the provincial executive and committees, (e.g., coordinating committee) on matters affecting physical education. **Policies & Procedures Page 7**

Article IV

Membership

Those eligible for membership are:

- a) All Federation members as defined in STF Policy 2.7.2(2)
- b) Membership shall be open to any person with a professional interest in physical education, health, wellness, recreation or sport.

Article V

Fees

Membership fees shall be established by resolution at the annual meeting of the Association. [Policies and Procedures Page 7](#)

Article VI

Officers' Roles and Responsibilities

The Association shall be managed and operated through a Board of Directors, representing all areas of the province and the various levels of education. To secure this intention, the Board will consist of the Executive, one Director representing each region and such a number of additional directors (known as members at large) as may be required and as established in the procedures and guidelines. The executive must be comprised of a minimum of five (5) members and a maximum of sixteen (16). The elected positions shall be the President and President Elect as determined by vote at the Annual General Meeting of the Association. [Policies and Procedures Pages 8-22](#)

Article VII

Annual General Meeting (AGM)

Article VIII

Representation

SPEA will follow the STF guidelines as provided for in Section 36 of the *Teachers Federation Act, 2006*. [Policies and Procedures Page 22](#)

Article IX

Amendments of Bylaws

- a. SPEA is a provincial association incorporated under the Non Profit Corporations Act 1995.
- b. After notice of motion to amend the constitution has been given, amendment may be effected by a two-thirds vote of members present at an annual meeting.

Article X

Dissolution

Dissolution of SPEA shall be affected by a two thirds vote of members present at an annual meeting. Remaining funds will be disbursed in the following way:

Subject to Section 47 of the Non Profit Corporations Act 1995, in the event of dissolution of the Association, its property and assets shall after payment of all liabilities, be donated to one or more recognized charitable organizations in Canada as may be decided by the Association at a general meeting.
